CSR Projects for the Financial Year 2025-26

The CSR Projects of the Company for the financial year 2025-26 will be implemented by Patanjali Yogpeeth Trust (“PYPT”), which is registered under section 12A and 80G of the Income Tax Act, 1961. The Trust is also registered with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) vide registration no. CSR00005364 for undertaking CSR activities.

The following projects have been duly approved by the ESG & CSR Committee and Board of Directors of the Company and will be implemented by Patanjali Yogpeeth Trust:

Project 1 - Construction of Girls Hostel: Construction of hostel building at the campus of University of Patanjali. An aggregate amount of ₹ 9,00,00,000/- (Rupees Nine Crore only) will be spent on this project by PYPT.

Project 2 – Construction of Indoor Stadium: Construction of indoor stadium building at Haridwar. The PYPT will spend an aggregate amount of ₹ 4,00,00,000/- (Rupee Four Crore only) on the construction of an indoor stadium building at Haridwar.

Project 3 – Installation of MRI Machine: Installation of an MRI machine at Patanjali Ayurved Hospital. The Company has already contributed an amount of ₹ 3,86,84,140/- (Rupees Three Crore Eighty-Six Lakh Eighty Four Thousand One Hundred Forty only) in the previous financial year and will contribute an additional amount of ₹ 5,00,00,000/- (Rupee Five Crore only) in financial year 2025-26.

Project 4 - Construction of Treatment Centre: Construction of treatment center building at Niramayam, Haridwar. The PYPT will spend an aggregate amount of ₹ 23,65,00,000/- (Rupee Twenty Three Crore Sixty Five Lakh only) on the construction of treatment center building.
