CSR Projects for the Financial Year 2026-27

The CSR projects of the Company for the financial year 2026-27 will be implemented by Patanjali Yogpeeth Trust ("PYPT") and Dholakia Foundation, both of which are registered under Sections 12A and 80G of the Income-tax Act, 1961. PYPT and Dholakia Foundation are also registered with the Ministry of Corporate Affairs (MCA) for undertaking CSR activities, vide Registration Nos. CSR00005364 and CSR00003461 respectively.

The following projects have been duly approved by the ESG & CSR Committee and the Board of Directors of the Company and will be implemented by Patanjali Yogpeeth Trust and Dholakia Foundation:

A. Projects Undertaken by Patanjali Yogpeeth Trust

Project 1 – Girls' Hostel

This project involves the procurement of furniture, installation of air conditioners, and acquisition of other movable assets for the Girls' Hostel at the University of Patanjali campus. An aggregate amount of ₹2,00,00,000 (Rupees Two Crore only) will be spent on this project by PYPT. The Company had already contributed ₹9,00,00,000 (Rupees Nine Crore only) towards this project in the previous financial year and will contribute an additional amount of ₹2,00,00,000 (Rupees Two Crore only) during the financial year 2026-27.

Project 2 – Construction of Sports Complex

This project involves the construction of a Sports Complex at Haridwar. PYPT will incur an aggregate expenditure of ₹8,00,00,000 (Rupees Eight Crore only) for the construction of the Sports Complex.

Project 3 – Construction of Treatment Centre and Patient Cottage

This project involves the construction of a Treatment Centre building and Patient Cottage at Niramayam, Haridwar. PYPT will spend an aggregate amount of ₹5,00,00,000 (Rupees Five Crore only) on this project. The Company had already contributed ₹4,00,00,000 (Rupees Four Crore only) in the previous financial year and will contribute an additional amount of ₹5,00,00,000 (Rupees Five Crore only) during the financial year 2026-27.

Summary of proposed expenditure on the above projects is as under:

Towards the above projects, the Company has to contribute CSR amount of ₹15,00,00,000 (Rupees Fifteen Crore only) to PYPT. The Trust aims to facilitate and promote education, sports, and healthcare facilities, and accordingly, the aforesaid projects fall within the activities specified under Schedule VII of the Companies Act, 2013 for the fulfilment of CSR obligations.

A. Project undertaken by Dholakia Foundation:

Recognising the need for impactful and scalable solutions to address India's growing water challenges, Dholakia Foundation ("the Foundation") is committed to restoring rivers across the country. The Foundation's ecosystem restoration initiatives commenced in 2017.

Mission Rivers is a flagship initiative of the Foundation aimed at conserving, protecting, and restoring rivers across India to support local ecosystems and communities. The Foundation has implemented more than 60 social and health-related initiatives, planted over 3 million trees, developed 155 lakes, and restored 53 kilometres of the Gagadiya River.

With a proven track record in scaling water conservation projects and delivering measurable impact, the Foundation seeks partnerships with organisations that share its vision of building a water-secure India.

The Foundation undertakes comprehensive social and environmental initiatives focused on water conservation and ecological restoration. These initiatives include the construction of lakes and dams, widening and deepening of rivers, and promoting biodiversity through habitat enhancement. Towards this initiative, the Company has to contribute ₹10,00,00,000 (Rupees Ten Crore only) as part of its CSR expenditure.
